EASY RIDER VEHICLE REQUIREMENTS

Even though we are an Easy Rider Jeep group, and most trails are rated easy, the conditions change frequently due to rains during monsoon season. Therefore, we have found that a passenger car is often not adequate. Therefore, the following paragraph contains the requirements of the Easy Rider trips.

A 4 Wheel Drive high clearance vehicle (8 inch minimum) is required, equipped with a working GMRS radio. The club expectation is to have an attachment point, front and back, for towing purposes. It is highly recommended that each vehicle carries a first aid kit, tow strap, shovel and fire extinguisher. See Recommended Gear for Off-roading list.

Trail ratings for Easy Rider trail runs are usually rated 2 - 4 but will not be over a 5 rating, but any trail may have ruts or wash outs. See Trail Rating document. Some of the trails may require airing down at the beginning and airing up at the end for added traction; therefore, you will need tire deflators and an air compressor.

Always bring chairs to sit on during picnic lunches on the trail. Also bring foul weather gear. Be sure to have plenty of water.

It is advised that you consult a map before departing and bring it with you so that you know the routes, in case you get separated during the time we are on the highway leading to the trail. We will always regroup at the start of the trail.
