Trail Rating Description

NOTE: The following descriptions are the generally accepted Trail Rating Descriptions. However, our groups have added the following: Although the first three (3) descriptions of these ratings do NOT call for 4-wheel drive OUR rules are that ALL vehicles on our runs MUST have 4-wheel drive and MINIMUM clearance of eight (8) inches.

- 1. The trail is a graded dirt road and is suitable for a normal passenger vehicle. It usually has gentle grades and is fairly wide.
- 2. SUV vehicles required. These trails are dirt roads but they may have rocks, grades, water crossings, or ruts that make clearance a concern.
- 3. Any SUV vehicle with at least six (6) inches of clearance; 4-wheel drive is recommended but not mandatory. Expect a rough road surface, mud, sand and small wash outs.
- 4. Four-wheel drive vehicles **REQUIRED** with clearance of six to nine (6-9) inches and expect a rough surface with rocks LARGER than six (6) inches but there will be reasonable driving line available.
- 5. Four-wheel drive vehicles **REQUIRED** with no less than nine (9) inches of clearance recommended. These trails may have either a rough, rutted surface, wash outs, rocks up to 9 inches
- 6. Four-wheel drive vehicles **REQUIRED** with modifications, Lockers or Posi-Trac recommended. These trails are for experienced four-wheel drivers. They are potentially dangerous with large rocks, wash outs, ruts or steep slopes that may need to be negotiated with a spotter. Certain sections may be steep enough to cause traction problems.
- 7. Four-wheel drive vehicles **MANDATORY, SKILLED, EXPERIENCED** four-wheel drivers **ONLY**. These trails include ALL the requirements above plus may require winching or towing.
- 8. Vehicles CAN expect body and under carriage damage and find the trail impassable. Trails with these difficulty ratings are for HIGHLY skilled, experienced four-wheel drivers ONLY. This rating includes ALL the requirements above from 5 rates trails to 7 rated trails.
- 9 to 10. This rating includes ALL the requirements above from 5 rated trails to 8 rated trails, plus can expect to find **ROLL-OVER SITUATIONS**.
